

ESTABLISHING AN ENVIRONMENTAL PURCHASING POLICY

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth of Massachusetts purchases an estimated \$600 million of goods and non-construction services per year, resulting in environmental and public health impacts related to the production, transport, use, and disposal of the products it consumes;

WHEREAS, it is now widely recognized that, through the procurement of environmentally preferable products and services, large institutions such as the Commonwealth of Massachusetts can directly reduce the environmental and health-related impacts of its consumption, lower life-cycle costs, promote local economic development, and serve as a model for businesses, institutions, and individual residents;



Two-state effort reduces public exposure to toxic chemicals

Salem, Ore., July 30: Government offices and schools across the Northwest will be healthier places to work and visit thanks to a new "green" janitorial supplies contract developed by Oregon's <u>Department of Administrative Services</u> in partnership with Washington's <u>Department of Enterprise Services</u>.

The contract – developed with support from the <u>Oregon Department of Environmental Quality</u>, <u>Washington Department of Ecology</u> and <u>Responsible Purchasing Network</u> – will supply public agencies with people- and planet-friendly janitorial supplies that reduce the use of toxic chemicals without increasing costs.

Copying & graphic paper - GPP Product Sheet

This product sheet forms part of the European Commission's GPP Training Toolkit, which can be downloaded from the GPP website

kit en.htm. Similar product sheets have been established for 10 other product and service groups. More information on the asons for selecting these criteria can be found in the detailed backg

For each product/service group two sets of criteria are presented:

- Core GPP criteria address the most significant environmental impacts, and are designed to be used with minimum additional verification effort or cost increases.
- Comprehensive GPP criteria are intended for use by authorities who seek to purchase the best environmental products available on the market, and may require additional administrative effort or imply a certain cost increase as compared to other products fulfilling the same function.

Scope

This sheet covers procurement actions for the purchase of copying and graphic paper. This encompasses unprinted paper for writing, printing and copying purposes (up to 170g/m²) sold in sheets or reels.

Finished paper products such as writing pads, drawing books, calendars, manuals, etc. have not been included. The criteria are taken from the European Ecolabel¹, the Nordic Swan label² and the Blue Angel label².
